


PINGYAO:
JING'S RESIDENCE

Jing's Residence is a boutique hotel located in the Shanxi Province, in the heart of the old town of Pingyao. Formerly the residence of a rich silk merchant, this traditional dwelling made of ancient carved wooden window frames, timber structural elements, bamboo flooring and rice paper ceilings has been fully renovated to its original condition. An inner courtyard comprised of nineteen bedrooms and suites that feature large nature motif vases exquisite lacquer chests and antiques, Jing's Residence is an exceptional property that reflects the owner's passion for the arts.

Food: Signature dishes include delicate pastries filled with rose jam.







Minyuan 33 is a charming boutique hotel with seven rooms located in the former British concession. Built in 1939 by a well-known local architect, the hotel was originally made of two rows of houses and featured a former wooden staircase and charming furniture that reflected the time and splendor of the British concession during the colonial period.

Food: The restaurant serves Chinese cuisine and grilled dishes.







Food: On the roof of the houseboat a feast awaits, from raita, pakora, leg of Lamb, yellow lentils, crispy nans and aubergine caviar.



Most fruits, vegetables, herbs and spices are grown in the garden.
