



# Birds of The Island Lodge



## Collared Kingfisher

- Turquoise blue and white
- Hovers and dives into water
- Loud, shrieking call, often fights with other kingfishers



## White-nest Swiftlet

- Small, dark gray
- Swoops and always changing direction
- Builds edible nest, considered a delicacy



## Great Egret

- Largest, all-white
- Black legs, yellow bill
- Stands still in the water



## Medium Egret

- Medium, all-white
- Black legs, yellow bill with a black tip
- Between Little and Great Egret in size



## Little Egret

- Smallest wading bird
- white body, black bill, black legs, yellow feet
- Often seen in shallow water



## Greater Coucal

- Large, black and brown
- Part of the cuckoo family
- Booming "coo-coo"



## Yellow-vented Bulbul

- Medium-sized, white head and black stripe
- Yellow under-rump, brown body
- Perches in shrubs and trees



## Ashy Tailorbird

- Small, gray, orange-red head
- Flits about
- Active in early morning



## Plain Prinia

- Small, brown, long tail
- Lighter brown belly
- Perches in tall grasses



## Coppersmith Barbet

- Small
- Red, yellow, and black clown face
- Pale green chest, darker green back



## Ashy Drongo

- Long-tail all-gray
- Flies fast over marsh
- October to April



## Laced Woodpecker

- Olive and buff-colored, red crown
- Dark tail with white streaks
- Uses its chisel-like bill to peck at tree trunks



## Common Tailorbird

- Olive-green back, white belly, orange cap
- Larger than the Ashy Tailorbird
- Long tail, slender bill



## Little Cormorant

- All-black, long neck and bill
- Seen in groups
- Swims with only its neck and head above water



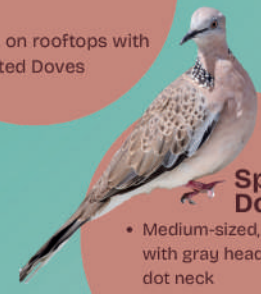
## Chinese Pond Heron

- Abundant in river
- Brown-striped body, white wings
- Same size as Little Egret



## Zebra Dove

- Gray with zebra-like stripes
- Small and hunched-over
- Seen on rooftops with Spotted Doves



## Spotted Dove

- Medium-sized, brown with gray head and polka-dot neck
- Soft "hoo-coo" call
- Perches on rooftops



## Golden-bellied Gerygone

- Small, brown back, yellow belly
- Short black bill
- Sits in palm trees



## Scaly Breasted Munia

- Small, reddish-brown
- Scale-like pattern on belly
- Visits grasses and nests in palm trees



## Brown-throated Sunbird

- Long nectar bill
- Yellow belly, dark back
- Rainbow shimmers



## Eurasian Tree Sparrow

- Small, brown with a black cheek patch
- Abundant in gardens
- Loves the lawn and thatched roofs
